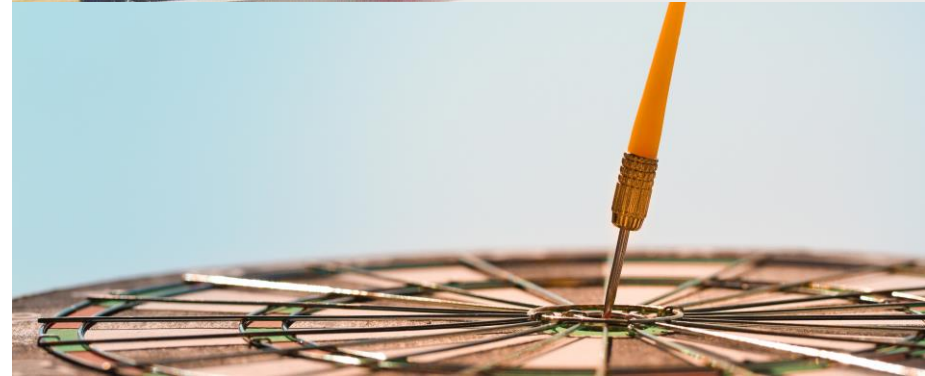

Benefits of our Collaboration

MEDIN Infrastructure



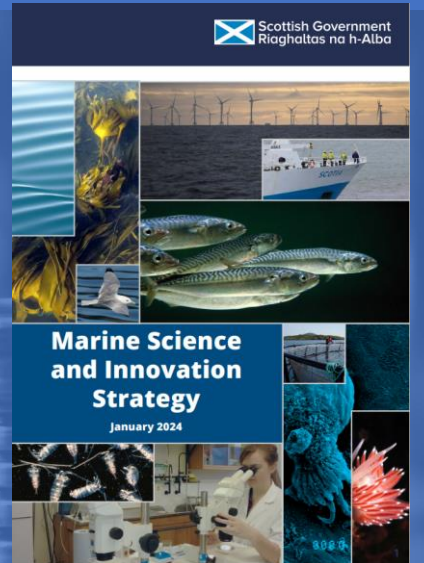
- Growing collection of searchable data in secure locations for the long-term increases value and protects investment in collection
- Context for change in the marine environment
- Shared standards that align with the long-term archives makes data life cycle management easier
- Still some challenges in adoption and integration of standards.
- Excellent method for co-development and early discovery for wider community
- Limitations in finances is curtailing MEDIN's ability to be a leading partner in this area.
- MEDIN portal exposes our metadata, no need to build another app for that – saving us money
- Enhanced machine readability of MEDIN portal is enhancing this approach significantly (e.g. Ocean Info Hub)

Operational

- Metadata standards adopted as our core way of describing data within the Marine Directorate.
- Adoption of persistent identifiers for datasets
- Invoking MEDIN standards in commissioned data collection
- Data Architecture focus on shared vocabularies and eventually API

Strategic

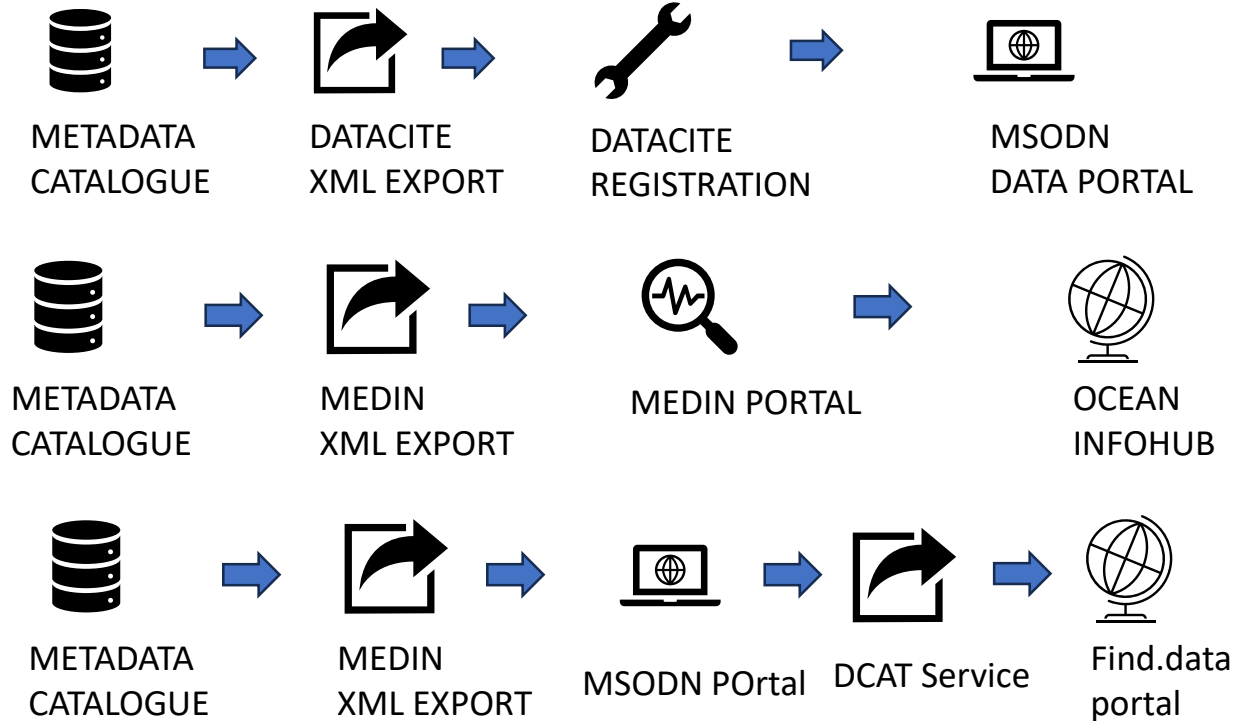
- Data and Digital as a strategic enabler

- Protect and enhance investment in assets (and data are assets)



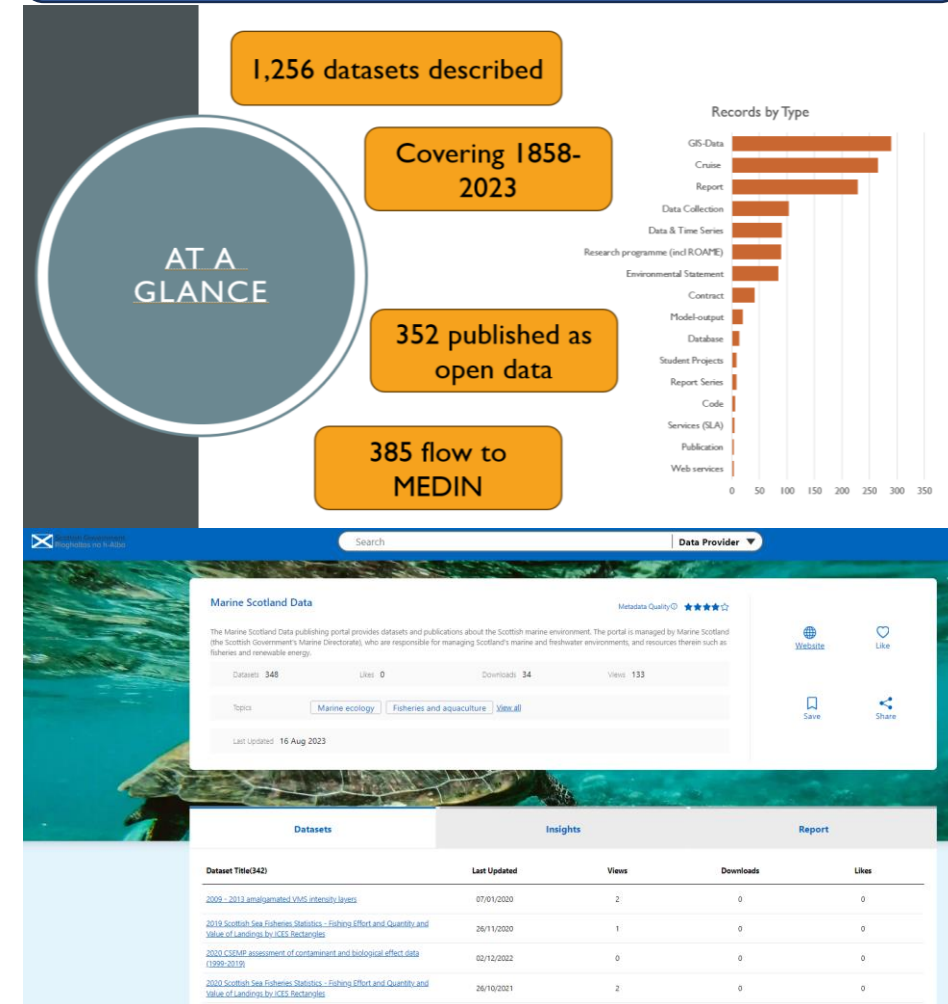
Examples

- Simplify workflows to provide multiple benefits



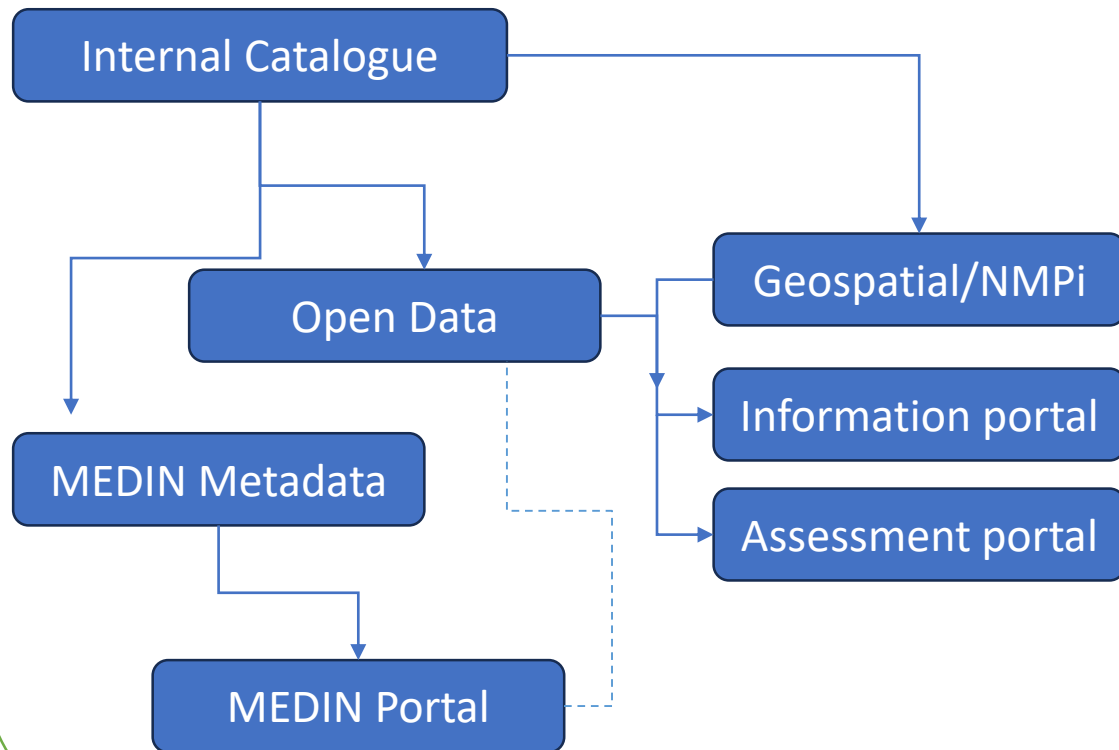
Custodians Need “only” complete their metadata and focus on good organisation of their dataset.



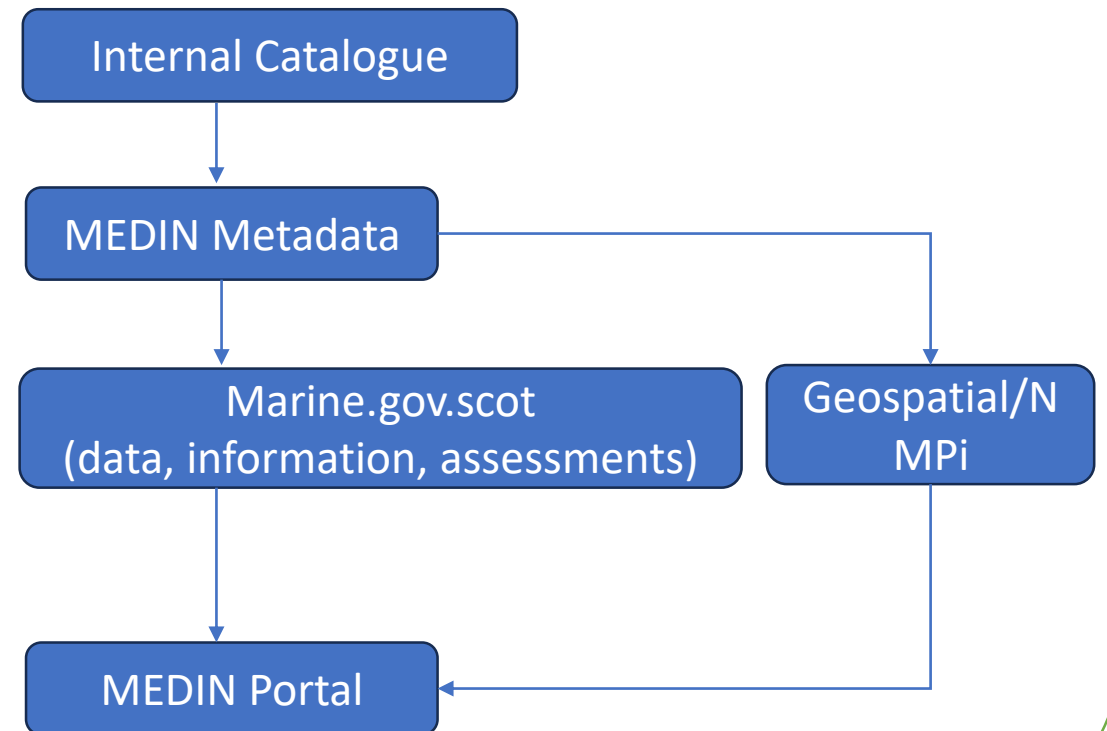
What's Next
